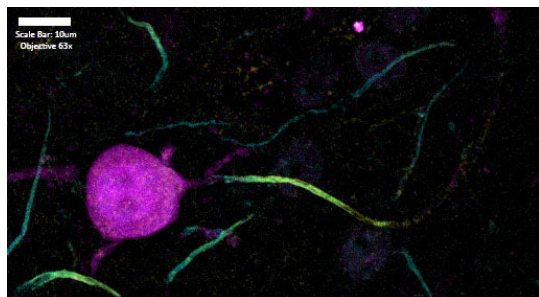

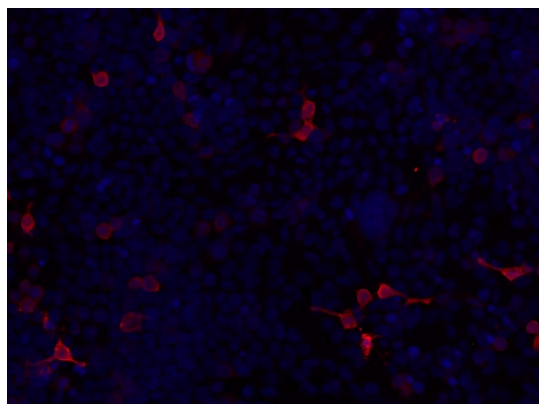

Specificity	No cross-reactivity against Kv1.1, Kv1.3, Kv1.4, Kv1.5 and Kv1.6 expressed in transfected cells
Molecular Weight	80 kDa

Quality Control	Each new lot of antibody is quality control tested by western blot on rat whole brain lysate and confirmed to stain the expected molecular weight band.
Storage	Aliquot and store at $\leq -20^{\circ}\text{C}$ for long term storage. For short term storage, store at $2-8^{\circ}\text{C}$. For maximum recovery of product, centrifuge the vial prior to removing the cap.

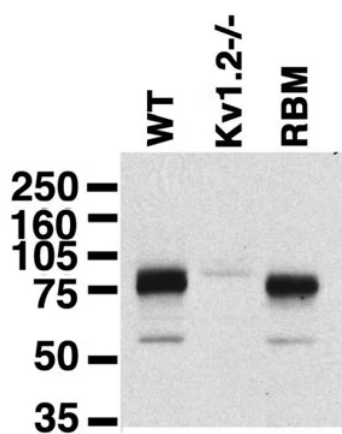

Immunolabeling of postnatal 14 mouse CA3 (Axonal Initial Segment, Parvalbumin positive interneuron) labeling Kv1.2 (75-008, 1:200, yellow) Parvalbumin (magenta), and Ankyrin G (cyan). Mice were transcardially perfused with cold 4% PFA in PBS, then brain removed and postfixed overnight. 50 μm slices as floating sections, antigen retrieval performed with sodium citrate at 80°C for 30 min. before immunolabeling.
