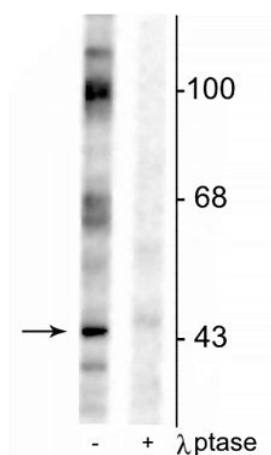

Immunogen	Synthetic phosphopeptide corresponding to amino acid residues surrounding the phospho Tyr317 of chicken EphrinB, conjugated to keyhole limpet hemocyanin (KLH). Note: Chicken Tyr317 is the homolog of rat and mouse Tyr328, human Tyr329 and Xenopus Tyr310.
Specificity	Specific for endogenous levels of the ~46 kDa EphrinB protein phosphorylated at Tyr317. Immunolabeling is completely eliminated by treatment with λ-phosphatase.

Quality Control	Western blots performed on each lot.

Storage	Storage at -20°C is recommended, as aliquots may be taken without freeze/thawing due to presence of 50% glycerol. Stable for at least 1 year at -20°C.
